

## PROTECTED FOREST LAND IN PERRY COUNTY (about 38% of total land)

### HOOSIER NATIONAL FOREST

Acreage in Perry County: 60,195 acres (April 2015 report) 25% of county land

No assessed value; No property tax revenue.

Hard to budget when amount varies from year to year.

Payment in Lieu of Taxes revenue (usually receive lump amount in June/July of each year).

### STATE FOREST LAND

Acreage in Perry County: approx. 3,700 acres 1.5% of land

No assessed value; No property tax revenue.

County receives small portion of Timber Sales revenue.

Cannot include in budget because amount varies so much from year to year.

#### Timber Sales Received:

50% of the below amounts stays in County General Fund; Other 50% goes to rural & volunteer fire departments:

FY 2014-2015: \$ 4,451.63

FY 2012-2013: \$ 559.21

FY 2011-2012: \$ 3,611.42

FY 2010-2011: \$19,506.33

### CLASSIFIED FOREST LAND

Acreage in Perry County: 27,691 acres 11.3% of land

Assessed value \$1.00 per acre.

Assessed value has been the same since 1962.

Over 1,600 acre increase in Classified land in the last 3 years.

Only 1 person in charge of monitoring the program.
